Session 2: June 16 – 20	Adventure Camp - Summer fun awaits! Campers will learn how to put up a tent, fish and hike safely. This transition skills camp provides how-to and safety information for various outdoor adventures.	
Session 3: July 14 – 18	Life Skills 101 - Different life skills will be covered this week so campers can acquire even more know-how and independence. Each Life Skills 101 Camp is different. Campers can register for just one session or both!
